2008 Summer Series Round 1

The Sporting Car Club Of Norfolk Ltd will promote a Clubsport Navigational Scatter on Sunday 27th July 2008. The event will start from the car park of the Green Man PH, Rackheath (MR 134 / 281 149½) and finish in the car park of the Ferry Inn PH, Honing (MR 134 / 346 164).

What is it?

Well it's a bit like a DIY 12 Car

- two time controls (start and finish)
- three hours to travel between them
- a list of points to visit (checkpoints)
- a simple Treasure Hunt type clue to solve at each checkpoint
- make up your own route

Can I do it?

The only navigational skill required is the ability to plot a 10 figure grid reference

What's a 10 figure grid reference?

A pointer to a 1 metre square on a 1:50000 OS map; 6 figures are the norm but 10 are more ascetic eg a 10 figure reference for the start would be 2810014950

What do I need?

- car (anything goes as long as it's taxed and insured)
- OS Landranger Map 134 (Norwich & The Broads, Great Yarmouth)
- pencils
- romer

What's a romer?

A small piece of plastic a bit like a very small ruler, if you're a Blue Peter fan then you can make your own but the club will have a supply available at the start

What else do I need to know?

- Help and advice will be available at the start
- The latest version of OS Landranger Map 134 would be advisable (currently D1) but any edition will do
- Bring the family, no limit to the number of passengers (apart from legal limits), the more eyes the better for clue solving although too many back-seat navigators may be a recipe for tears before bedtime, if you're Johnny-no-mates then there's no reason why you can't do it on your lonesome
- Food is available locally before the event and at the finish

Marking & Penalties

- Time limit of 3 hours
 - Early arrival at the finish – no penalty
 - Late arrival at the finish - 1 point deduction per minute late up to a maximum lateness of 15 minutes
- Four types of checkpoints
 - A 1 point Answer at the checkpoint reference
 - B 2 points Answer within 50m of the checkpoint reference
 - C 2 points Answer at the checkpoint
 - D 4 points Answer in the general checkpoint area
- Checkpoints A & B will be defined by a Grid Reference
- Checkpoints C & D will be defined by simple Plot & Bash – the route defined by the Plot & Bash **DOES NOT NEED TO BE DRIVEN** – you only need to drive to the checkpoint and solve the clue
- There will be 40 checkpoints
 - Points will only be scored for visiting 75% (30 for any non-mathematicians)
 - The checkpoints will be split
 - A 14
 - B 14
 - C 6
 - D 6
 - Obviously checkpoint D's will be the most time consuming
 - The maximum score possible is $68 = (D \times 6) 24 + (C \times 6) 12 + (B \times 14) 28 + (A \times 4) 4$
 - The maximum score without worrying about the Plot & Bash is 42 (but if you're worried about the Plot & Bash seek advice at the start and all will be well - honestly)
- Overall positions will be determined by total points scored
 - Ties will be decided by answers to Motor Sport questions dreamt up by the Organiser (or good old fashioned bribery if he doesn't have to drive home).
- There will be only one class
- There will be no awards
