Supplementary Regulations

Article 1 - ANNOUNCEMENT

- 1.1 The Sporting Car Club Of Norfolk Ltd will organise and promote a Clubsport Production Car Sealed Surface Autotest on Thursday 29th July 2010 at Snetterton Circuit, Norfolk NR16 2JU (enter via Map Ref: 144 / 007½ 896).

Article 2 - JURISDICTION

- 2.1 The event will be held under the General Regulations of The Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A.), these Supplementary Regulations and any other written instructions the organising club may issue for the event.

Article 3 - AUTHORISATIONS

- 3.1 MSA Clubsport permit number 600013 has been issued.

Article 4 - ELIGIBILITY & CHAMPIONSHIPS

- 4.1 The event is open to all fully elected and associate members of the promoting club, Cambridge CC, Chelmsford MC, Eastern Counties MC, Kings Lynn & DMC, West Essex CC and West Suffolk MC.
4.2 All entrants and drivers must produce a valid club membership card.
4.3 The event is a round of the Sporting Car Club of Norfolk Summer Series Championship, only fully elected and associate members of the organising club can claim championship points.

Article 6 - CLASSES

- 6.1 The event will consist of two classes:
RWD All rear wheel drive cars
FWD All front wheel drive cars.
6.2 Four wheel drive vehicles are not permitted.

Article 7 - ROUTE & FORMAT

- 7.1 The entire event will take place within the confines of Snetterton Circuit.
7.2 The event will comprise of 3 tests.
7.3 M15 details of the tests will be available at signing on.
7.4 M15 each driver will have 3 runs at each test – best 2 times to count.
7.5 M15 drivers will be identified by time cards which will be provided by the organisers.
7.6 M15 timing will be by hand held stop watches to the previous whole second.
7.7 M15 the starting signal will be either 'in your own time' or '5-4-3-2-1-GO'.

Article 8 - AWARDS

- 8.1 There may be some awards.

Article 9 - ENTRIES

- 9.1 The entry fee is £23.75 per car for a single drive, £27.50 per car for a double drive. Cheques should be made payable to Sporting Car Club Of Norfolk Ltd (or to SCCON Ltd).

13.3 Ties will stand.

Article 14 - JUDGES OF FACT

- 14.1 All signed on marshals and Timekeepers are Judges of Fact and will be appointed as per G10.1 to adjudicate and report on M8.

Article 15 - MISCELLANEOUS

- 15.1 Tyres should be 'ordinary' and road legal; racing tyres, moulded slicks and 'knobbles' are not permitted.
15.2 A reminder to entrants, a passenger must be carried which implies that the car must be fitted with at least two front seats.
