Welcome to the Your Ideal Shop 12 Car sponsored by Chris Edwards and organised by Howard Joynt & Bernie Fox. Starting from the Media Centre, Snetterton Circuit and finishing at Scoulton Village Hall; using maps 134 & 144.

### Supplementary Regulations

1. The Sporting Car Club of Norfolk Ltd. (SCCoN) will promote a Clubsport 12 Car on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> January 2012.
2. The event will be governed by the general regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these supplementary regulations and any further written instructions the organising club may issue for the event.
3. An MSA Clubman permit tbc has been allocated, which will be displayed at signing-on.
4. The event is open to full and associate members of SCCoN.
5. The event is a qualifying round of the SCCoN 12 Car Championship.
6. The maximum entry for the event is 12 and the minimum is 6. The entry list opens on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> January 2012 and closes on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> January 2012. If the minimum number of entries is not reached by Friday 20<sup>th</sup> January 2012 the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event and refund entry fees in full.
7. All vehicles in addition to complying with technical regulation R18 **must carry a red warning triangle and should carry a basic first aid kit.**
8. The event will start from the Media Centre, Snetterton Circuit NR16 2JU (144 / 001½ 892 – enter via 144 / 007½ 896).  
The total mileage will be approximately 60 miles, all official times and mileages will be deemed correct and no protests will be allowed regarding this.  
Signing-on will commence at 6:30 pm.  
The first car will start at 8:01 pm with the other cars following at 1 minute intervals.  
The finish will be at Scoulton Village Hall, Scoulton NR9 4NZ (144 / 985 010).
9. O.S. Landranger maps 134 D2 & 144 B3 will be required.
10. All entries must be sent, including a completed entry form and an entry fee of £17.50 to the Secretary of the meeting: Howard Joynt, White Cottage, 2 Watton Road, Griston, Thetford IP25 6QF. Tel 07917 060052. (Cheques must be made payable to Sporting Car Club of Norfolk Ltd)
11. Results will be published as soon as possible following the end of the event. Ties will be decided in accordance with R15.2.
12. Classes: Beginner, Novice, Intermediate and Expert. Classification into classes will be at the discretion of the Championship Coordinator, based on the navigator's previous experience.
13. Timing will be by clocks held by marshals to the requirements of 'Scheduled Time'.
14. Entrants will be supplied with a time card, list of Out of Bounds and Give Way junctions at signing-on. Route information will be given at various points on route. These documents will provide all information necessary to comply with R14.1 – R14.1.8.
15. The organisers may establish a control or check at any point to ensure compliance with route instructions, speed schedule, Give Way junctions, technical regulations and noise.

16. Penalties: In accordance with R13 using the fails system applied to scheduled timed events.

17. Give Ways (R9.1.1 - R9.1.4).

Competitors are required to stop within 2 metres before the Give Way line (or where it would be).

**ALL WHEELS MUST BE SEEN TO STOP AND ALL MOTION MUST CEASE**

18. Awards: At the discretion of the organisers.

19. Controls will open 10 minutes before the scheduled time of arrival of the first car and close 30 minutes after the scheduled time of arrival of the last car. **To qualify as a finisher, the crew must present their time card at the final competitive time control within 45 minutes of their scheduled time of arrival at that control**

20. At the discretion of the Clerk of the Course the Route Instructions may be class specific.

21. Insurance.

Competitors are reminded that "normal" car insurance does not cover them for competitive motoring. Competition insurance can be arranged through SCCON on a pay as you compete basis, (£17.50 per event), providing you can sign the following Declaration.

This is done at signing on and does not require the completion of a proposal form in advance.

1. I am over 21 and have held a full licence for at least SIX months.
2. I have had not more than ONE fault accident in the last three years.
3. I have no more than a maximum of SIX speeding points on my licence
4. I have no physical or mental disabilities.
5. I have no other material facts to disclose.

22. Further Information.

Petrol will not be available near the start.

A sump guard is not needed

SCCoN championship points will be awarded as per the championship rules.

Competitors will be identified by registration plate and at Time Controls by their time cards.
