Welcome to the Canada Garage Motorsport 12 Car sponsored by and organised by Mark & Lorraine Annison.

Supplementary Regulations

1. The Sporting Car Club of Norfolk Ltd. (SCCoN) will promote a 12 Car Navigational Rally on Friday 22nd February 2019.
2. The event will be governed by the general regulations of the Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these supplementary regulations and any further written instructions the organising club may issue for the event.
3. A Motorsport UK Clubmans permit **111526** has been allocated, which will be displayed at signing-on.
4. The event is open to full and associate members of SCCoN. Club cards will be inspected at signing-on.
5. The event is a qualifying round of the SCCoN 12 Car Championship.
6. The maximum entry for the event is 12. The entry list opens on publication of these Supplementary Regulations (approximately Wednesday 6th February 2019) and closes on Friday 15th February 2019.
7. All vehicles in addition to complying with technical regulation R18 **must carry a red warning triangle and should carry a basic first aid kit.**
8. The event will start from:
Alby Horse Shoes Inn, Erpingham NR11 7QE (133 / 207½ 324½)
The total mileage will be approximately 60 miles, all official times and mileages will be deemed correct and no protests will be allowed regarding this.
Signing-on will commence at 6:00 pm.
The first car will start at 8:01 pm with the other cars following at 2-minute intervals.
The event will finish at:
Alby Horse Shoes Inn, Erpingham NR11 7QE (133 / 207½ 324½)
9. O.S. Landranger map 133 latest editions will be required.
If **133** was purchased after August 2018 the legend should state **Revised August 2018** otherwise **Revised September 2013** or **Edition D3**.

11. Please enter and pay using the online system available from the website. A paper entry form is available by request from the Entries Secretary:

12. Marshals please register using the online system available from the website or contact the Chief Marshal.
13. Results will be published as soon as possible following the end of the event. Ties will be decided in accordance with R15.2.
14. Classes: Beginner, Novice, Intermediate and Expert. Classification into classes will be at the discretion of the Championship Coordinator, based on the navigator's previous experience.
15. Timing will be by clocks held by marshals to the requirements of 'Scheduled Time'.
16. Entrants will be supplied with a time card and a list of 'Out of Bounds' areas at signing-on. Route information will be given at various points on route. These documents will provide all information necessary to comply with R14.1 – R14.1.8.
17. The organisers may establish a control or check at any point to ensure compliance with route instructions, speed schedule, Give Way junctions, technical regulations and noise.

18. Penalties: In accordance with R13 using the fails system applied to scheduled timed events.
19. Give Ways (R9.1.1 - R9.1.4).
Competitors must stop before entering any road protected by a Stop sign, stopping within 2 metres before the Stop line (or where it would be).

ALL WHEELS MUST BE SEEN TO STOP AND ALL MOTION MUST CEASE

20. Awards: At the discretion of the organisers.
21. Controls will open 10 minutes before the scheduled time of arrival of the first car and close 30 minutes after the scheduled time of arrival of the last car. **To qualify as a finisher, the crew must present their time card at the final competitive time control within 45 minutes of their scheduled time of arrival at that control**
22. At the discretion of the Clerk of the Course the Route Instructions may be class specific.
23. Insurance.

Competitors must have Insurance in place which provides Third Party Liability cover that complies with the Road Traffic Act (RTA). This can be an extension to the existing motor policy for the car or purchased via the event organisers. If a competitor uses an extension to an existing policy, they will be required to sign a declaration that the cover complies with the requirements of the RTA. Any responsibility for a fraudulent or misleading declaration about existing cover lies with the competitor.

The Organisers have applied to Jelf Insurance Partnership for a Blanket Cover Note under their Rally Guard Scheme which will provide competitors who need to use the scheme with the Third Party Cover necessary to meet RTA requirements on the Road Sections of the event.

The basic rate for the event before any loadings will be **£17.00**.

All applicants wishing to use the scheme must be able to comply with all points of the Jelf Insurance Partnership's Declaration:-

1. I do not have the Third Party Road Section extension on my current Motor Insurance
2. I am aged 20 or over
3. I have had no more than 1 fault claim in the last three years
4. I have no more than maximum of 6 conviction points on my UK driving licence
5. I have the appropriate competition / club membership licence as well as a UK / EU driving licence and if my licence is provisional I will be supervised by an adult over 25
6. I have no physical or mental disabilities
7. My vehicle is MOT'd, Taxed and Insured for the road.
8. I have no other material facts to disclose

Anyone aged less than 20 years old will also be accepted at the same price should their navigator be a more senior member of their family or over 25.

If you are unable to comply with any of the above points you will need to complete a Driver Declaration Form (available from the Event Secretary) and send it off allowing sufficient time for a letter of acceptance to be issued by Jelf Insurance Partnership.

24. By submitting an entry for this event, I agree to the following: **"I declare that my vehicle is MOT'd, Taxed and Insured for the road."**
25. Further Information.
- Petrol will be available near the start.
- The route has been driven in a standard car, but a sump guard would be advisable for the more enthusiastic drivers.
- SCCoN championship points will be awarded as per the championship rules.
- Competitors will be identified by registration plate and at Time Controls by their time cards.
