What is a Navigational Scatter? It's a bit like a DIY 12 Car, start control, finish control, set time limit, a list of points to visit, a simple Treasure Hunt type clue to be answered at each point, make up your own route to get from the start to the finish within the time limit, points scored for correct answers, points deducted for being late at the finish

Can I do it? The only navigational skill required is the ability to find your way to a map feature (church, PH, telephone box etc) in a kilometre grid square on a 1:50000 OS Landranger Map

What do I need? Car (anything goes, if it is taxed and insured), OS Landranger Map(s), Pencils, Watch

Supplementary Regulations

Article 1 - ANNOUNCEMENT

1.1 The Sporting Car Club of Norfolk Ltd will organise and promote a Clubmans Navigational Scatter on Sunday 10th June 2018 starting from Stacey Fields Pavilion, Rackheath (Map Ref: 134 / 278¾ 139¼).

Article 2 - JURISDICTION

2.1 The event will be held under the General Regulations of The Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A.), these Supplementary Regulations and any other written instructions the organising club may issue for the event.

Article 3 - AUTHORISATIONS

3.1 MSA Clubmans permit number **107166** has been issued.

Article 4 - ELIGIBILITY & CHAMPIONSHIPS

4.1 The event is open to all fully elected and associate members of the promoting club, Cambridge CC, Chelmsford MC, Disabled Racing Drivers CC, Eastern Counties MC, Falcon MC, Green Belt MC, Kings Lynn & DMC, Middlesex County AC, West Suffolk MC and Wickford AC.

4.2 All drivers must produce a valid club membership card.

Article 5 - TIMETABLE

5.1 Entries open on publication of these Supplementary Regulations and close on 10th June 2018.

Article 6 - CLASSES

6.1 The event will consist of two classes:

T	Three
O	One.

Article 7 - ROUTE & FORMAT

7.1 The event will start from: Stacey Fields Pavilion, Green Lane West, Rackheath, NORWICH NR13 6LT (134 / 278¾ 139¼).

7.2 The event will finish at: New Victory Hall, Street Hill, Neatishead, NORWICH NR12 8XG (134 / 340 210).

7.3 The total mileage will be approximately 30 miles.

7.4 Map number 134 will be required.

7.5 At signing on information containing Blackspots etc. will be issued. The location of the points to be visited will be issued at your start time. **Competitors will be required to visit no more than 75% of the locations.** At each location there will be two simple treasure hunt type questions to answer as proof of visiting. Question 1, worth 1 point, competitors will be able to answer without leaving the car. Question 2, worth 2 points, (at most points) competitors will be required to leave their cars and walk unspecified reasonable distances to answer. Competitors in Class O will only require answers to the 1 point questions. Competitors in Class T will require answers to both the 1 point and 2 point questions. If there are 40

locations to visit the maximum locations that can be visited for both classes is 30 and the maximum points possible for Class O is 30 and for class T is 90.

- 7.5 There will be **no** treasures to be collected en route, instead, there will be a simple quiz made up of crossword type clues to be completed en route. The quiz is optional and the answers will only be used as a tie breaker.

Article 8 - AWARDS

- 8.1 There may be some awards.


Article 9 - ENTRIES

- 9.1 The entry fee is £10 per car. Pay on the day: cash or cheque. Cheques should be made payable to Sporting Car Club of Norfolk Ltd (SCCON Ltd).

- 9.2 **On line entry preferred.**

| 11.1 | Fully correct answer to questions | 1 / 2 point for each correct answer |

| 11.4 | For reporting later than scheduled finish time | 1 point per minute will be deducted up to a max of 10 minutes lateness then Exclusion |
| 11.5 | For action contrary to the spirit of the event | Ticking Off / Named & Shamed |
| 11.6 | For bad driving, contravening Traffic Regulations or the Highway Code, excessive speed, excessive noise or driving likely to bring the sport into disrepute | Ticking Off / Named & Shamed |
| 11.7 | Use of satellite or GPS receiver | Ticking Off / Named & Shamed |
| 11.8 | Use of the interwebby | Ticking Off / Named & Shamed |

Article 12 - RESULTS, TIES AND PROTESTS

- 12.1 Interim, provisional and final results will be published on the Official Notice Board.

- 12.2 Results will be published as soon as possible after the finish of the event.

- 12.3 Ties will be resolved in accordance with M9.3.

Article 13 - CLARIFICATION

- 13.1 There will be more than one question to answer at all points.

- 13.2 The **75% rule ONLY** applies to **POINTS VISITED**.

- 13.3 11.4 will be **STRICTLY ENFORCED**.

- 13.4 11.1 is defined as an answer that **EXACTLY** matches the organiser's answer.

- 13.5 11.2 is defined as an answer that very nearly matches the organiser's answer e.g. spelling mistake, missing word(s), case etc
