## **Supplementary Regulations**

### **Article 1 - ANNOUNCEMENT**

1.1 The Sporting Car Club of Norfolk Ltd will organise and promote a dual permit Clubmans Grass Production Car Autotest and Autotest on 19<sup>th</sup> July 2018 near Illington, THETFORD IP24 1RP (enter via Map Ref: 144 / 936¾ 896¾).

### **Article 2 - JURISDICTION**

2.1 The event will be held under the General Regulations of The Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A.), these Supplementary Regulations and any other written instructions the organising club may issue for the event.

### **Article 3 - AUTHORISATIONS**

3.1 MSA Clubmans permit numbers *tbc & tbc* have been issued.

### **Article 4 - ELIGIBILITY & CHAMPIONSHIPS**

4.1 The event is open to all fully elected and associate members of the promoting club, Cambridge CC, Chelmsford MC, Disabled Racing Drivers CC, Eastern Counties MC, Falcon MC, Green Belt MC, Herts County A & AC, Kings Lynn & DMC, Middlesex County AC, West Suffolk MC and Wickford AC.

4.2 All drivers must produce a valid club membership card.

### **Article 5 - TIMETABLE**

5.1 Entries open on publication of these Supplementary Regulations and close on 19<sup>th</sup> July 2018.

### **Article 6 - CLASSES**

6.1 The event will consist of two classes:

A	Autotest	No passenger required
P	Production Car Autotest	Passenger required

6.2 Four-wheel drive vehicles are not permitted.

### **Article 7 - ROUTE & FORMAT**

7.1 The entire event will take place on private land.

7.2 The event will comprise of at least 2 tests.

7.3 M15 (a) details of the tests will be available at signing on.

7.4 M15 (b) each driver will have at least 3 runs at each test – **ALL** times to count.

7.5 M15 (c) drivers will be identified by time cards which will be provided by the organisers.

7.6 M15 (d) timing will be by hand held stop watches to the previous whole 1/10<sup>th</sup> second.

7.7 M15 (e) the starting signal will be 'in your own time'.

### **Article 8 - AWARDS**

8.1 There will be no awards.

## **Article 9 - ENTRIES**

9.1 The entry fee is £10 per driver, free if the driver is under 18. Cheques should be made payable to Sporting Car Club of Norfolk Ltd (or to SCCON Ltd).

9.2 Online entry will be available from the club website.

## **Article 11 - MARKING AND PENALTIES**

11.1 Performance will be assessed as in Table M.7- PCA.

## **Article 12 - MODIFICATIONS TO THE GENERAL REGULATIONS**

All other General Regulations of The Motor Sports Association apply, except for the following which are modified:

12.1 M6 posts or pylons may be less than 1 metre high.

## **Article 13 - RESULTS, TIES AND PROTESTS**

13.1 Interim, provisional and final results will be published on the Official Notice Board.

13.2 Results will be published as soon as possible after the finish of the event.

13.3 Ties will be resolved in accordance with M9.3.

## **Article 14 - JUDGES OF FACT**

14.1 All signed on Marshals and Timekeepers are Judges of Fact to adjudicate in accordance with M8.

## **Article 15 – SPILL KIT**

15.1 All vehicles should carry a small spill kit complying with J5.20.13.

## **Article 16 – MINIMUM AGES**

16.1 Entries may be accepted from drivers who are 14 and over. However, for drivers not holding a full RTA Licence, the passenger must hold a full RTA Licence and be experienced in Autotesting.

16.2 Passengers must be 12 years or over. However, for passengers not holding a full RTA Licence, the driver must hold a full RTA Licence.
