Supplementary Regulations

1. The Sporting Car Club of Norfolk Ltd. (SCCoN) will promote a Table Top Rally on Thursday 15th November 2018.
2. The event will be governed by the general regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these supplementary regulations and any further written instructions the organising club may issue for the event.
3. An MSA permit is not required.
4. The event is open to anyone; membership of the organising club is not required.
5. The event is a qualifying round of the 2018 SCCoN Clubmans Series Championship.
6. The maximum entry for the event is 20. The entry list opens on publication of these regulations.
7. Vehicles are optional.
8. The event will take place at the White Horse Inn, Trowse
The total mileage will be approximately 40 miles, all official times and mileages will be deemed correct and no protests will be allowed regarding this.
Signing-on will commence at 7:30 pm.
Route Cards will be available at 8:00 pm.
9. O.S. Landranger map 134 D3 will be required, for maps purchased after February 2016 the map legend should read 'Revised July 2012'.
10. There is NO paper Entry Form (but you will be able to have a go at the new Online Entry Form) and NO Entry Fee. An indication of intent to enter would be appreciated. 11. Results will be published as soon as possible following the end of the event. Ties will be decided by some fiendish process yet to be dreamt up
12. Classes: Novice and Expert.
13. No Timing.
14. Entrants will be supplied with a Route Card when they start.
15. Route Checks
 - a. Some route checks will be simple, some will not (a calculator may be useful as some route checks will involve simple mathematics i.e. addition, subtraction, division, multiplication)
 - b. All the route checks will require counting or adding up 'things' and then perhaps performing some simple maths, penalties will be calculated based on the proximity to 'the correct' answer
 - c. Always read all the instructions on the route cards very carefully, correct interpretation will be the key to success

16. Penalties: In accordance with the Easy Peasy Table Top Rally rules the marks system applied to scheduled timed events:

- a. Blank Route Check 300 marks
- b. Incorrect Route Check (see 15)

17. Awards: At the discretion of the organisers.

18. Controls

- a. Start - MTC1
 - i. Open 20:00
 - ii. Close 21:30
- b. Finish - MTC2
 - i. Open 20:00
 - ii. Close when everyone has had enough

19. At the discretion of the Clerk of the Course the Route Instructions may be class specific.

20. Insurance will not be required

21. Further Information.

- a. Fuel will be available before, during and after the event.
- b. Tables will be provided.
- c. SCCoN championship points will be awarded as per the championship rules.
