Welcome to The Brecks Table Top Rally organised by Percy.

Supplementary Regulations

1. The Sporting Car Club of Norfolk Ltd. (SCCoN) will promote a Table Top Rally running throughout April 2022.
2. The event is open to anyone; membership of the organising club is not required.
3. The event is not a round of any Championship.
4. There is no maximum entry for the event. Entries open on 1st March 2022.
5. The event will take place on a table at your convenience.
All documentation will be available from the SCCoN website.
Route Cards will be available from 8:00 am on Friday 1st April 2022.
Final date for submission of Answer Forms will be 6:00 pm on Sunday 30th April 2022.
6. The latest revision of O.S. Landranger map 144 will have a map legend reading 'Revised May 2019', the navigation will also be checked against the previous revision with a map legend reading 'Revised June 2013'.
7. Please use the Online Registration Form (only required if you intend to submit Answer Forms and want to be classified in the results) and there is NO Entry Fee. Entries will be accepted from individuals or teams. Entries Secretary: David Bell. Tel 01603 720 871. Email percy@scccon.co.uk.
8. Results will be published as soon as possible following the end of the event. After each submission of an Answer Form a provisional summary of penalties will be updated, answer forms for legs can be submitted many times, the last submission for each leg will be used for the final results.
9. Classes: Novice and Expert. Each class will have a different route with its own route checks. Novice navigation will be at a similar level to that handed out to Experts on a SCCoN 12 Car. Expert navigation may be challenging.
10. The event will be continuous with 4 legs, each leg with 5 sections. Each leg will have a start reference and an end reference, the end of a leg will be the start of the next leg. There will be no link sections between sections. As on a 12 car, unless specifically indicated, no road can be used more than once. Each route card will indicate which classification of roads will be used on that section. CRO - coloured roads only for navigation and route. CAR - consider all roads for navigation but CRO for route. WUW - consider all roads for navigation and route.
11. Route checks will be in the form of 100 x 10 figure grid references, each route check will have a unique reference, for each leg simply record the route check references in the order your route passes through them with the direction of approach and the direction of depart, all route checks will be on junctions, not all route checks will be used. Please submit one Answer Form per leg. The sections do not have to be done in order but be aware that the route of another section may affect the route for the current section. Multiple submission of Answer Forms for a leg is fine, the last submission received before the closing date will be the one to be marked.
12. Penalties:
 - a. No attempt at a section 5 marks for each route check on the section
 - b. Missed route check 5 marks
 - c. Route check wrong approach 1 mark
 - d. Route check wrong depart 1 mark
 - e. Route check out of sequence 2 marks

13. Further Information.

- a. All the documentation needed - Registration Form, Route Cards, Answer Forms – links will be available on the club website.
- b. All sections count towards the event result.
- c. General queries can be emailed and will be answered but route specific queries will be answered with a 'no comment'.
- d. Route checks may well change as answers are submitted; results will remain provisional for 7 days after they have been published.
- e. It is all meant as a bit of light relief, do not be put off if you have absolutely no idea on a particular section, all navigation is based on a very small set of basics, the hints available should be enough for the penny to drop.
- f. It is not a race, you have a month, do not worry if you inadvertently submit a blank answer form, use the Comments box if necessary and the results will be based on the last Answer Forms submitted before the closing date.
- g. All forms that can be submitted will have a Comments box, this can be used to ask for hints or point out mistakes.
