Announcement.

The Sporting Car Club of Norfolk Ltd will organise and promote a dual permit Clubmans Stubble Production Car Autotest (PCA) and Autotest (AT) on Saturday 11th October near Illington, THETFORD IP24 1RP (enter via Map Ref: 144 / 936¾ 896¾).

1 Jurisdiction.

The meeting will be held under the National Competition Rules of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions the promoting club may issue for the event. National Competition Rules of Motorsport UK (NCR) can be found on the Motorsport UK (MSUK) website and event specific regulations can be found in Chapter 19 AUTOTEST (NCR19) on the MSUK website.

2 Authorisations.

Motorsport UK Clubmans permit numbers tbc & tbc have been issued.

3 Competitor Eligibility.

The event is open to paid up members of SCCoN and to paid up members of motor clubs that are member clubs of AMSC (Anglia Motor Sport Club). If the event is oversubscribed, priority will be given to SCCoN crews, then to crews with one SCCoN member and finally to crews from other clubs. Within those three groups, participants with a fully completed entry form will be given priority.

6 Double Drive.

Interim results MAY be available during the event.

12 Route, Format & Penalties.

The entire event will take place within the confines of a grass / stubble field.

The event will comprise of 2 tests.

NCF	R19 App.1 para 1.4	
(a)	details of the tests will be included in the pre-event documentation	
(b)	each driver will have a minimum of 2 runs at each test - ALL scores to count	
(c)	drivers will be identified by numbered score cards which will be included in the pre-event documentation	
(d)	timing will be by hand held stop watches to the previous tenth of a second	
(e)	the starting signal will be 'in your own time'	
(f)	PCA – a passenger will be mandatory	
	AutoTest – a passenger will not be allowed	
(g)	results will be calculated from marshal check sheets	
(h)	performance will be assessed as per – App.9 – Penalty Table	
(i)	ALL scores to count	
(j)	in the event of a tie the Competitor who was first to have the lesser penalty from the start will be adjudged to win the tie	

13 Modifications to the General Regulations.

All other General Regulations of The Motor Sports Association apply, except for the following which are modified:

NCR19 App.1 para 2.7	posts or pylons may be less than 1 metre high

14 Judges of Fact.

All signed on Marshals and Timekeepers are Judges of Fact to adjudicate in accordance with NCR19 App.1 para 4.

15 Final Instructions.

Final Instructions will be emailed during the week prior to the event, to the email address provided on the entry form.

16 Minimum Ages.

Entries may be accepted from drivers who are 14 and over. However, for drivers not holding a full RTA Licence, the passenger must hold a full RTA Licence and be experienced in Autotesting.

Passengers must be 12 years or over. However, for passengers not holding a full RTA Licence, the driver must hold a full RTA Licence.

17 Micras.

All drivers must use a Micra.

Club Micras will be available for drivers who do not have a Micra of their own.

Club Micras must be booked on the entry form.

18 Marshals.

Marshals, please register using the on-line registration form on the website.
